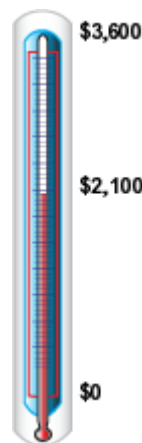
Our prayer for you is that each of you would experience God's love in a supernatural way this Christmas and that 2009 would be a year filled with His awesome power!

July 6-12, 2009



We have been asked and accepted the invitation by Evangelism International, Inc. to join them as part of the ministry team for the upcoming 2009 crusade.

Mumias, Kenya, where the 2009 crusade will take place, is a small crossroads of the Western Province in Kenya. While the population of Mumias is just under 100,000, the surrounding district has nearly a half million total population. It also lies about 30 miles from the

Uganda border, thus enhancing its strategic value in regards to evangelism.

We will be sharing more details in our upcoming newsletters during the first quarter of 2009.

Please be in prayer as we will be meeting in January to continue discussing the details and budget of the July 2009 crusade.
